**TO REMEMBER FOR THE FIRST NIGHT OF CLASS**

**REQUIRED:** An up-to-date INOCULATION RECORD from your vet. We need to know the date and type of all immunizations your canine has received. (We require 2 DHLPP.)

**RECOMMENDED:** Results from a fecal exam for internal parasites within 3 weeks of the start of class.

**BUCKLE COLLAR:** Plain, good quality leather or nylon Slip collars are acceptable for dogs older than 6 months. Prong collars are prohibited in this beginner's Class.

**6 FOOT LEASH:** Good quality, flat leather, nylon or canvas, chain or rope.  
(Leather is gentler on your hands.)  
Should be separate from the collar and have a loop for a handle.

**FOOD TREATS:** Small tidbits to MOTIVATE your dog.

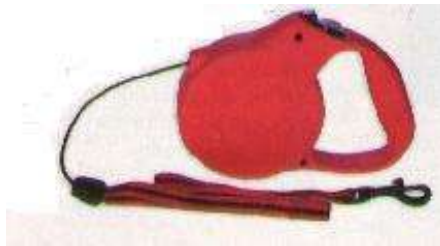
**WATER DISH:** non-breakable

Please wear comfortable clothing and low heeled, soft soled shoes.

And, of course.....YOUR CANINE. ***DO NOT FEED HIM/HER 4 HOURS BEFORE CLASS.***

***THE LEASH AND COLLAR***

The leash and collar are two of your most important pieces of training equipment. Good quality equipment will last a long time and be effective in helping you teach your dog. Poor quality, inappropriate or ill-fitting equipment can hinder your teaching and potentially become dangerous should it break or come loose. Pay special attention to the snaps and other hardware.

Please arrive early and give your dog a chance to relief himself/herself before entering the building. Often the excitement of a new place with smells of other dogs will encourage your dog to toilet. Be sure to give him/her a chance to toilet outside before entering our building.

Just a reminder: 24 hour notice of cancellation required for private lessons. These sessions are prepared on an individual basis. Often another student is waiting to start once a time slot opens. Pre-planning and communication are helpful.
